## What strategies do you think the City of Burnaby should adopt to foster the growth and success of our local businesses?

Opening up areas in the city for small businesses to operate in, bringing back a 15min walkable city will allow more opportunities for local business development to bring them closer to customers. Reduce the Permitting time and tangle, have a dedicated small business department and team to work with the BBOT and businesses to streamline processes, such as online tracking of permits – what stage are they at?

## How would you propose the City of Burnaby manage its continued densification and the development of its town centers?

The Densification needs to expand along the transit routes, bringing in more business spaces, housing, childcare, etc.
