The Access Program is a career development initiative designed by the Burnaby Board of Trade (BBOT) to bridge the skill gap for post-secondary students and enhance their professional readiness. By collaborating with post-secondary institutions and businesses, this program provides students with invaluable networking opportunities, practical training, and direct industry engagement, enabling a smoother transition into the workforce.

The Burnaby Board of Trade (BBOT) is one of the most influential business associations in British Columbia, fostering economic growth and community development. STRUCTURE

Duration & Timeline

The Access program is designed to be a 4-month long program, starting in April 2025 and culminating in July 2025.

Participants in the program would be guaranteed a minimum of three engagements per month, ensuring continuous learning and networking.

Eligibility & Cost

Students currently enrolled in post-secondary institutions across BC, in the last 2 years of their program, are welcome to apply to be a part of the Access program. Upon successful completion of the program, participants will receive a certificate of completion and a letter of reference from the Burnaby Board of Trade.

Student membership fee: \$100 for the entire program

*financial aid may be provided to eligible students in need







PROGRAM COMPONENTS

The Access Program offers a comprehensive set of initiatives designed to equip students with the skills, knowledge, and professional connections necessary for career success. Through mentorship, targeted training, networking opportunities, and real-world business challenges, participants will gain valuable experience and direct access to industry professionals. The following components outline the key elements of the program:

01/ MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The Mentorship Program is a core pillar of the Access Program, designed to provide students with an invaluable opportunity to be matched with a business professional who will provide professional insights and support as students transition from post-secondary institutions into the workplace. This initiative fosters meaningful professional relationships, equipping students with industry insights, career strategies, and workplace readiness skills. By engaging with seasoned mentors, students gain valuable perspectives that enhance their employability and confidence as they transition from academia to the workforce.

KEY FFATURES

Structured Mentorship Matching

Students are paired with mentors based on their field of study, career interests, and professional goals.

One-on-One & Group Mentorship

A combination of individual guidance and group discussions ensures diverse learning opportunities. The program will maintain a Mentor-to-student ratio of 1:5, thus ensuring meaningful engagement.

Monthly Check-ins & Progress Reviews

Regular mentor-mentee meetings to track development and provide targeted advice.

Networking & Industry Exposure

Mentor-led events and panel discussions with industry leaders.

Final Reflection

Students summarize their learnings and present key takeaways from their mentorship experience.

02/ TRAINING & WEBINARS

Students enrolled in the Access program will have access to dedicated trainings & workshops to provide them with the opportunity to connect with experts on a broad range of topics related to professional skills, personal development, standing out in a job search, building a professional brand, and building a business network.

Digital Skills & Software Training

This training module equips students with knowledge of essential software and digital tools commonly employed in modern workplaces. Participants will gain an understanding in productivity suites, project management platforms, and data analysis tools to enhance their technical competency and efficiency in professional settings.

Soft Skills Development

Effective communication and interpersonal skills are crucial for career success. This training module focuses on enhancing students' public speaking, teamwork, and leadership abilities, helping them build confidence and adaptability in diverse professional environments.

Professional Development Workshops

Specialized sessions covering topics like leadership, career planning, workplace ethics, and industry trends.

HR Workshop Series

These sessions will aim to provide insights into effective job search strategies, including resume building and interview preparation. Students will have the opportunity to interact with HR professionals to understand hiring trends, employer expectations, and best practices for securing employment.

03/ NETWORKING EVENTS

Students enrolled in the Access program will have the opportunity to attend exclusive networking events as well as a variety of over 50 Burnaby Board of Trade events throughout the year, offering them the opportunity to network with Burnaby business and community leaders.

Speed-dating Style Roundtables

These structured networking sessions allow students to interact with multiple industry professionals in a short period of time. Each roundtable session is designed to facilitate meaningful conversations, helping students gain insights into different career paths and industry expectations.

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04/ CAREER & JOB FAIR

The Access program will culminate with a career fair style event, aimed at providing students with a platform to find jobs and secure interviews to help kick-start their careers after graduation.

Exclusive Recruitment Opportunities With Program Partners

All participating businesses will offer students unique access to job openings, internships, and entry-level roles. This direct engagement increases students' chances of securing meaningful employment opportunities.

Fast-track Interview Process

Companies involved in the job fair will commit to an expedited interview process for program participants. This ensures that students are not just directed to generic job postings but are given real hiring opportunities (avoiding generic 'apply online' responses).

Elevator Pitch Style Interview Sessions

Students will participate in short, structured interview rounds with recruiters, providing an opportunity to showcase their skills and personalities directly to hiring professionals in a dynamic and engaging format.

*Pre-screening of all registered students will be done based on business needs as communicated by the participating companies.
